Winifred was diagnosed with epilepsy a few years ago. He was having fits in the middle of the night and his family did not know what was wrong with him. At one point they thought football was causing the fits and his Mama was going to stop him attending training at Lengo. During a visit to his family in 2016 we soon realised that the fits could have been caused by epilepsy. We sought sponsorship to take him to the hospital for testing and he was

soon diagnosed with epilepsy. He has been on medication since and he has not had a fit since he has been on the medication.

An update from Winifred

"I started playing for Lengo since I was six years old. At that time, I was very little. As a child and in this culture we must play football on the street and I loved playing football barefoot, with a handmade ball, and with my friends and older brothers. I never realised that football could change my life and that one day it would be a big part of my life. It's something that is valuable in my life and my family's life. Growing up I faced hardship with a disease that I didn't know what it was. But through Lengo I came to realise what was wrong with me and I was sponsored to get treatment, which I am on today. I also get other benefits and opportunities to develop my talent which will potentially guide me to reach my dreams of becoming an
